100 Medical Careers

Studies will gain a basic understanding of the systems of the body with associated medical terminology and diseases, basic patient care, taking vital signs, charting, medical ethics as well as understanding patient privacy laws.

Students will be introduced to one hundred different medical career pathways. Students will complete a work-based learning experience (community classroom) in an on-site fully functional medical clinic. With the completion of this four year program and receiving a high school diploma, students will have the competency requirements to register for the California State Examination to become a certified Medical Assistant.

Apprenticeship

In partnership with the Open Tech Los Angeles Regional Apprenticeship Collaborative, this apprenticeship program is setting a goal to train 1,000 at-risk youth for careers in high-growth technology and biotechnology jobs.

The innovation at the heart of its new model is the Talent Incubator, a for-profit social enterprise that creates embedded training models for individuals, like at-risk youth, who need a customized training program in order to succeed.

Course Curriculum Includes:

- up-to 400 hours minimum (unpaid) classroom training leading to an industry recognized credential
